



Directions Good Dogs Know

FOLLOW	When you're away from your home base, this lets your dog know you're the leader.
LET'S GO	Companion command to Follow/Heel; this command redirects your dog.
SIT	The canine equivalent of "please."
DOWN	Time to relax.
STAND	Stand still.
STAY	Grounding command.
WAIT	Quick check-in before entering a new area or having a snack.
COME	The canine equivalent of the sports term "Huddle".
UNDER	Direct your dog under your legs or a table for emotional security.
BACK	Step back or stand behind me for protection.
AWAY	To reinforce personal space.
GIVE or DROP	Teaching your dog to release anything held in his mouth.
NO	Impulse control. Teaches him to avoid a specific behavior.
DIRECTIONAL SIGNALS	Reflects daily routines like CAR or GO TO YOUR BED. Also used for familiar names like DAD or LINDSAY.
